Emergency Food Pantry Program Updates

We have some changes happening with our Food Pantry starting Monday, October 2, 2023.

Schedule Changes:

<u>Monday</u>: appointment only pickups from 9:15am-12:15pm

<u>Tuesday</u>: appointment only pickups from 1:45pm-4:30pm (*no change*)

<u>Wednesday</u>: appointment only pickups from 10:30am-12:15pm and 1:45pm-5:30pm (*no change*)

Friday: Delivery Day- deliveries are made to



households with no transportation *and* an approved referral on file. Deliveries will now be grouped by geographic area. For example, everyone that lives in Dryden will be delivered on the same Friday.

Annual Paperwork Update:

Starting October 2, 2023, you will be asked to fill out annual paperwork as a pantry participant. This paperwork includes an agency intake form, The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) form and a disclosure form. This only needs to be completed once a year. We can assist you to complete the packet.

If you have a delivery referral with us, it will also need to be updated. We will work with you and the agency that gave you the referral so there is no interruption to your deliveries.
