It is with profound sadness that we mark the passing of our former Executive Director, Lee Dillon on January 28, 2023. Lee began her career at the agency in 1985 as a Housing Inspector and became a fierce advocate for those hard to house and experiencing homelessness. She was a founding member of the Continuum of Care that established guidelines to ensure those with the greatest

need were housed first in coordination with all county agencies. She was instrumental in bringing New York State Homeless Housing and Supportive Housing funds into the county, resulting in numerous buildings serving the homeless, providing supportive services and meeting the needs of those gripped by substance use dependence. In 2000, she became the agency's Executive Director, working in that capacity until her retirement in 2021. In addition, she served on NYS Community Action Association Board of Directors and was an active participant and presenter for NYS Supportive Housing Network. Under her leadership, Tompkins Community Action expanded and integrated services for individuals and families living in poverty in an effort to move those impacted toward self-sufficiency and she did so with respect and passion for all those served.


